Preface

The technology advancement is shifting the focus of new generation from print to electronic education. The students seem reluctant to write. Insufficient opportunities for writing on paper could develop illegible handwriting of upcoming students. In order to keep from developing poor handwriting, Dar-ul-Madinah International University Press has developed a series of five (5) handwriting books for primary level students that offers a variety of writing opportunities to develop neat and legible writing. Selection of font has been the focal centre of this series so that the students enjoy handwriting and practise in a fun way. Learn to Write series contains two (2) print handwriting books for beginners, followed by three (3) cursive handwriting books for advanced learners. It encompasses sufficient practice and logical progression from hollow letters to tracing between narrow lines, writing from narrow to broad lines independently, letters to words, words to phrases phrases to sentences, sentences to paragraphs, and paragraphs to age-appropriate text types. Assessment at each level serves as a checkpoint for the teachers to evaluate the students' mastery over handwriting skills.

Learn to Write Print Handwriting Book 2 presents a brief overview of alphabet. Beginning with short words, the book offers a variety of long words and a collection of vocabulary for tracing and writing practice. The vocabulary includes numbers in words, objects at home and school, vegetables, fruits, seasons, weather, ordinal numbers, shapes, countries, animals, birds and professions. The journey of sentence writing begins with conversation and leads up to writing long sentences with even space between words. By tracing and writing everyday sentences, not only will the students learn to write better, they will also be able to use these sentences in their daily conversation. Writing short and legible paragraphs independently is the desired outcome of this book.

Guidelines for Teachers

- Make sure the students identify and recall the correct shape and formation of each letter tracing it between lines. The beginning dots on letters will help them.
- Make sure they write each letter in its correct position between the lines.
- Do not allow even minor deviation from the correct formation and size of letters.
- While writing a sentence, advise the students to leave even space between words.
- Make sure they do not miss any punctuation mark while writing.
- · Give your remarks each time the students practise handwriting.
- · Keep appreciating the students. Encourage them to write even better.

Handwriting Postures

- At the time of writing, sit the students properly.
- Make sure that the book is at a reasonable distance from the eyes of students.
- Have them hold the pencil between the thumb and two initial fingers of the writing hand.
- Make sure the grip is neither too tight nor too loose.
- Have them put their non-writing hand on writing book.



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- After recalling alphabet, the book offers sufficient practice for writing short, long and mixed vocabulary words.
- Assessment shows how much the student has mastered the handwriting skill in actuality.
- 3 Independent writing of small sentences in quantity will prepare the students for writing paragraphs.
- Writing paragraphs neatly, legibly and independently without any help, by each student, is the actual target of this book.
